Thessaloniki

Acts 17:1–10 1 Thessalonians

Acts 16:11-40

Visit the Ancient Colony of Philippi, founded in 356 B.C. by Philip II. Highlights include the Ancient Theatre, the Church of Philippi (Europe's first), and the Baptistery of St. Lydia. Next, onto Kavala for a panoramic view of the Port of Neapolis—Paul's first European landing. Lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a short walk along Via Egnatia, tracing Paul's steps to Thessaloniki.

Visit Ancient Corinth, the archaeological site of Acrocorinth, the Bema of Gallio, the Erastus inscription, and one of Greece's richest museums (Acts 18:1-17; 19:22). Stop at a traditional olive oil mill for a tasting, then visit Cenchreae (Acts 18:18). On the way to Athens, we'll stop at the Isthmus of Corinth.







Cruise Destinations

Mykonos Port of Kusadasi Heraklion

The Ancient Ephesus Bus Tour explores one of the largest Roman archaeological sites in the Mediterranean, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Founded 3,000 years ago, Ephesus was a major center of commerce and spirituality, known for the Temple of Artemis and connections to Apostles Paul and John and the Virgin Mary. We'll visit iconic sites like the Agora, Odeon, Houses of the Patricians, Temple of Hadrian, and the Library of Celsus, and enjoy time to shop for local goods. After returning to the ship, we'll sail to Patmos to visit the Monastery of St. John and the Grotto of Revelation.
